COAD for Monroe County, Indiana (MoCOAD) serves as an organizational network of representatives from public, private and not-for-profit agencies. Our mission is to enhance the community's ability to mitigate, prevent, prepare for, respond to and recover from large-scale disasters, thus ensuring that human needs in a disaster situation are evaluated and addressed.

MoCOAD Goals

- Identify those community organizations and resources that can be called upon when a disaster strikes.
- Facilitate communication & coordination among these organizations that want to help when help is needed.
- Successfully link needs to services during disaster recovery efforts.

What is a "COAD"?

- A diversified, organized group of non-profit, governmental, volunteer, faith-based, public service organizations and businesses, who meet regularly in order to be prepared to share their time, talents and resources during a community disaster.
- A collaborative group that, during times when traditional services and resources may be overwhelmed, seeks to minimize duplication of services and strives to meet unmet needs by identifying disaster victims and pairing them with services that offer practical and timely assistance.

How to participate in MoCOAD:

1. **Stay Informed:** Sign up for the MoCOAD email update including news and meeting alerts.
2. **Register as a Resource:** Complete a Resource Registry Form to include how your organization can help after a disaster strikes.
3. **Become a Member:** Attend meetings and vote on MoCOAD issues.
